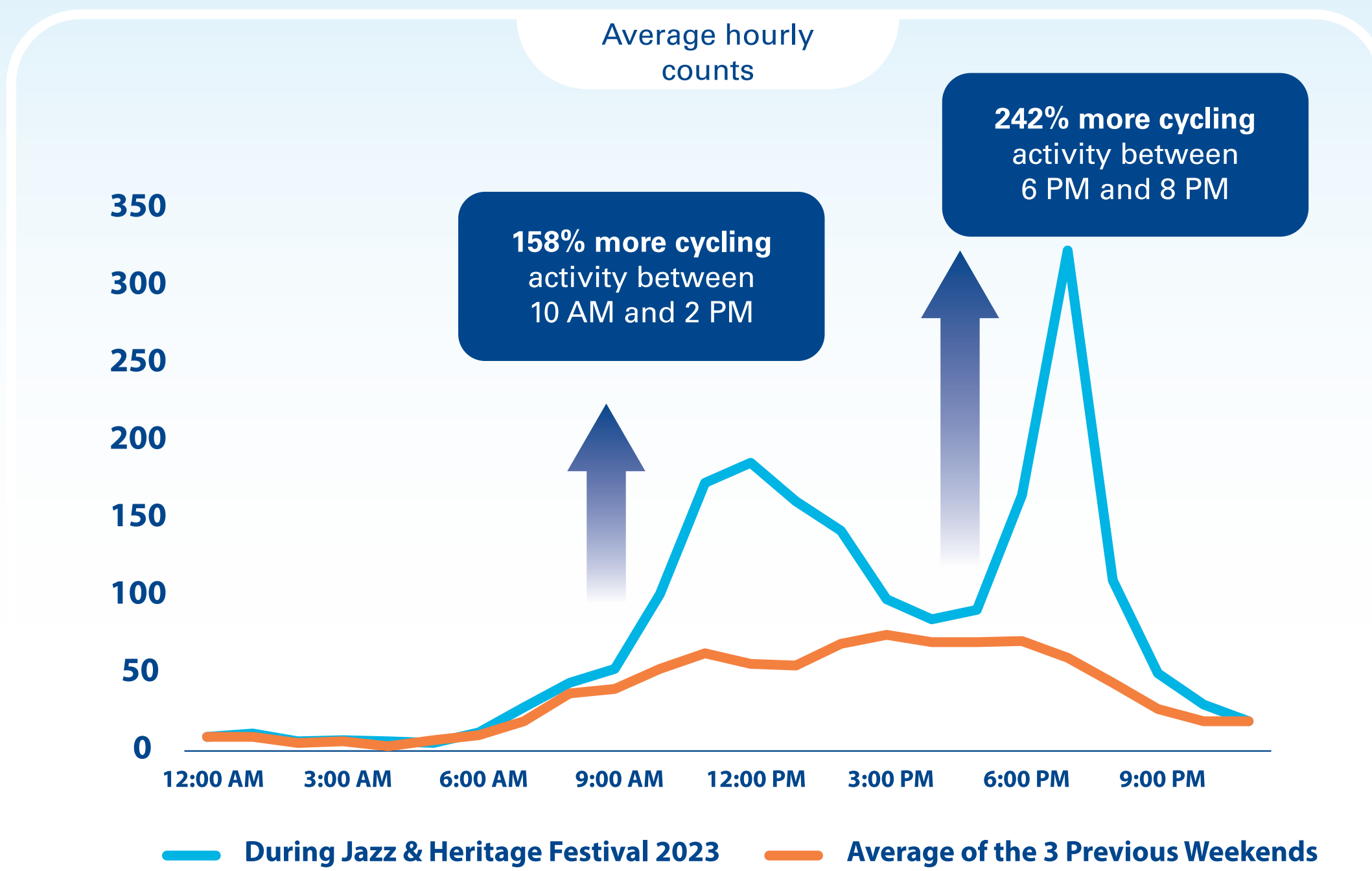

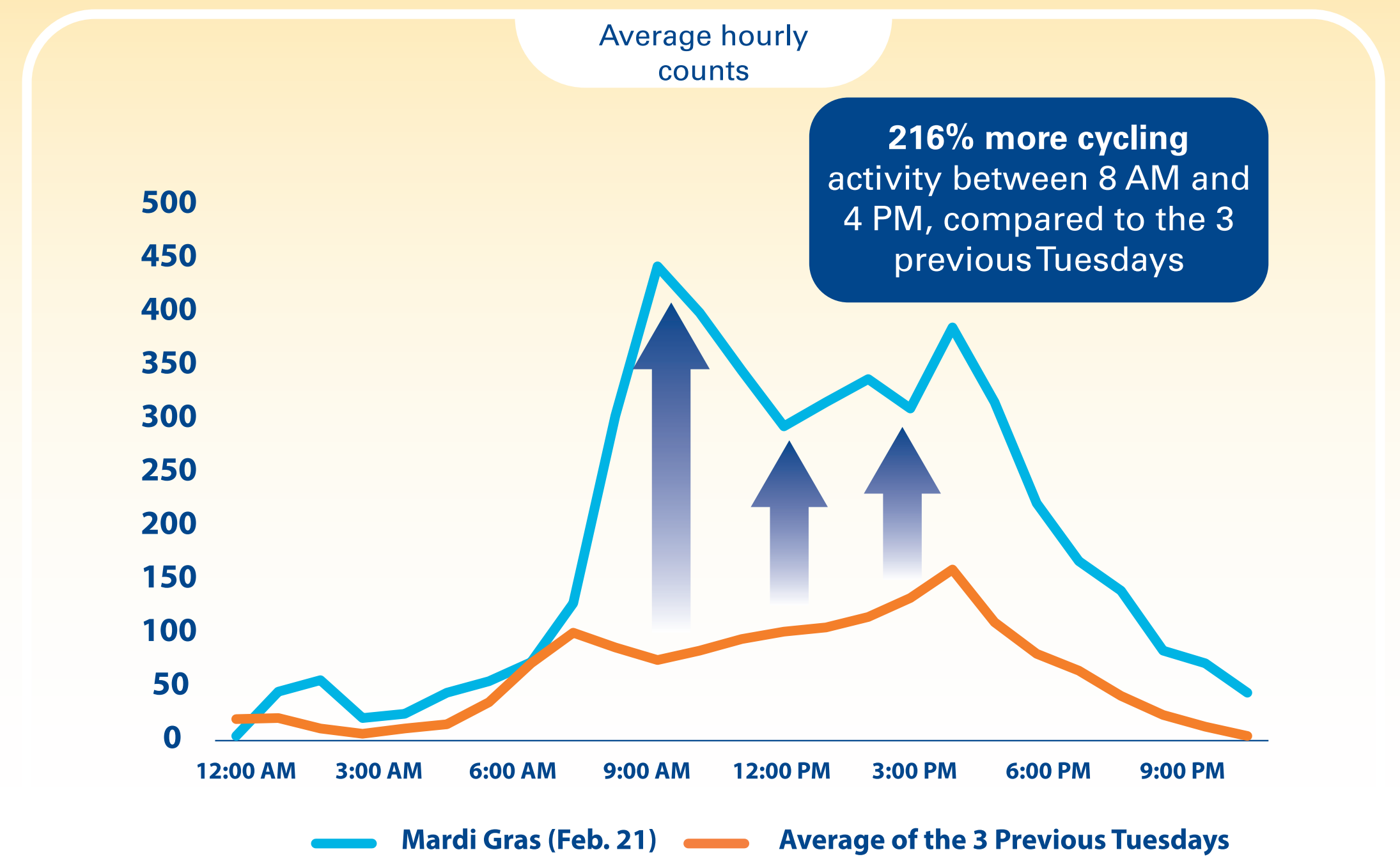

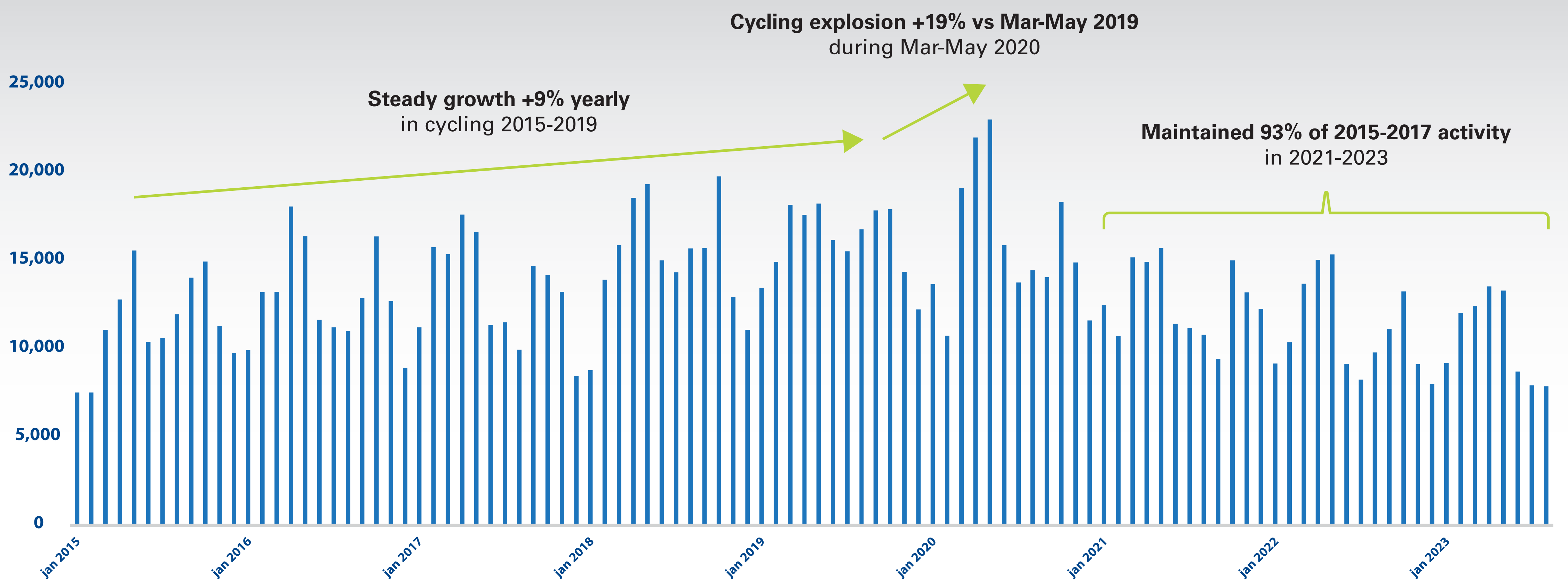
Bikes counted during Mardi Gras 2023
